

What you can expect on Saturday, December 1st at the Bay Club Hotel & Marina:

The evening will begin with cocktails and hors d'oeuvres in the Commodore Room which has a view of the pool and marina, looking towards Point Loma. The refreshments will be ready at 6:30 PM and will include roasted red pepper hummus with crisp pita; vegetable crudité with ranch dressing; vegetable spring rolls with honey mustard sauce; chilled shrimp cocktail with cocktail sauce. **Your first 2 drinks and the hors d'oeuvres are courtesy of Thompson Building Materials, RCP Block & Brick, ORCO Block & Hardscape, Eldorado Stone, and Creative Mines! Thank you, one and all!!!!**

The bar will be stocked with call brands, some premium brands, house wine, domestic beer, import bottled beer, and assorted soft drinks. IT WILL BE A CASH BAR THEREAFTER, at which time if there is something special you want to drink and it is not available at our patio bar, you are welcome to try the bar in the hotel lobby.

Back by popular demand, beginning at 7:00 PM in the Harbor Room (just across the hall), Casino Concepts will provide 4 hours of Casino Games, including 2 Craps tables, 2 Black Jack tables, and Roulette for your gambling pleasure. Upon arrival, every attendee will receive a GOLD COIN which can be cashed in *at any casino table* in exchange for \$500 in chips. \$20 re-buys will be for sale throughout the night for any player who runs out of chips and wants to keep playing.

If you're not a gambler, you are welcome to stay in the Commodore Room to enjoy the live musical stylings of our own Eddie Albano from RCP.

The Dinner Buffet will be served in the Spinnaker Room (just across the hall) at 7:45 PM (to 9:15) and will include tossed salad, turkey with homemade gravy and cranberry relish, prime rib with creamy horseradish + au jus, wild rice, oven roasted potatoes, seasonal vegetable medley, rolls and butter, and cheesecake with strawberry sauce for dessert. Those who have reserved a room at the hotel and plan to stay overnight will get a permit from the front desk when they check in. Those of you just coming for the party do not need a permit.
